The legendary “Red Rider”, Rodney Jenkins, is a member of the show jumping Hall of Fame, also the National Show Hunter Hall of Fame.

Walter "Timmy" Kees

We are honored to announce a new judge on the TTHS roster, Walter “Timmy” Kees.

With over 30 years experience on the ‘A’ horse show circuit, W.T. ‘Timmy’ Kees is one of the country’s most prominent hunter/equitation trainers. Raised in Maryland riding in pony club events and galloping his mother’s race horses, Timmy began his career by selling horses from the race track to George Morris and Ronnie Mutch. He later joined Mutch as Assistant Trainer at Nimrod Farm in Weston, CT.

Timmy’s riders have won the ASPCA Maclay, AHSA Medal and USET equitation finals a total of seven times.

Timmy is an USEF ‘R’ judge and conducts clinics throughout the country. He was recently inducted into the National Show Hunter Hall of Fame.
