DEBBIE'S TUDE assumed the early lead, set the pace along the rail, was urged leaving the far turn and dug in tenaciously under brisk urging. GINGER N RYE saved ground both turns, angled out turning for home and rallied. NORTHERN SMILE, along the inner rail both turns, rallied inside horses and was steered out late. MONSTER SLEEPING, two wide both turns, swung to the four path in upper stretch, raced outside horses and failed to menace. VIELSALM, steadied and shuffled back shortly after the start, circled the far turn three deep and flattened out. CANDIDA H. chased the pace two wide and gave way.
