

QUEEN CAROLINE rated kindly in the clear and about three wide, took closer order into the far turn, went after HOOLIGAN near the quarter pole, dueled then gained a short lead a furlong out, responded to strong right handed rousing, moved clear leaving the sixteenth pole and held firm while under a solid hand ride the final seventy yards. SECRET OR NOT rated in the two path just behind the leaders, drafted towards the rail around the final turn, altered out in upper stretch, straightened away and finished with good energy. HOOLIGAN sprinted clear early and set the pace towards the rail, handled outside pressure from NANCY'S GONE WILD entering the far turn, moved clear again after six furlongs, was hooked from her outside by QUEEN CAROLINE near the quarter pole, dueled past the furlong grounds then gave way grudgingly. SWEET SANDY settled well off the early pace while saving ground, came off

the rail and progressed between runners near mid stretch, altered out soon after and continued with interest. GEM settled off the rail, crept closer after six furlongs, angled five wide but lacked a solid finish. COMPLETE ST., in range and off the inside, was under pressure between rivals leaving the three eighths, steadied near the quarter pole then came up empty. MAGICIAN'S VANITY saved ground, was shuffled back nearing the half mile marker, gained along the fence in mid stretch then flattened out. FOR FINERY, four to five wide, gained leaving the far turn, pursued into the stretch then gave way. ANDRASTA, three wide leaving the far turn, weakened. NANCY'S GONE WILD prompted the pace two wide, moved to apply more pressure into the far turn, was under urging trying to keep pace past the five sixteenths then tired. CLOCKSTRUCKTWELVE, rated wide past the five eighths, gave way. ELEGANT BREEZE saved ground early and tired.
