## Footnotes

COCO AS IN CHANEL sprinted to the early lead, set the pace near the rail, drifted out badly in mid stretch and lasted. ELEGANT SUPERMODEL (GER), a forward factor along the down the backstretch and on the turn, swung to the four path entering the stretch, drifted out a bit in mid stretch and rallied on her left lead. HIDDEN TREAT raced in the two path around the turn and in the stretch and rallied mildly. DAYLIGHT AHEAD, checked in tight quarters leaving the backstretch, steadied leaving the turn, raced in the three path in the stretch and rallied inside horses. SUMMER FROCK, four wide on the turn, failed to rally. JULERETTE chased the pace outside the winner around the turn and gave way in mid stretch. DO WHAT I SAY, four wide on the turn, bobbled approaching the stretch. TAP DIVA hugged the inner rail and was lightly steadied mid way on the turn. RAMBLIN N GAMBLIN chased the pace three wide around the turn and faltered entering the stretch.
