TWO NOTCH ROAD rated close up, steadied briefly nearing the three eighths, regrouped to track the dueling leaders into the lane, responded when set down, forged to command near the sixteenth marker and drew clear under a drive. MOON RIVER, off the early pace three wide, moved up four wide under hustling ride into the lane, rallied between rivals and nabbed the place in the final strides. AVAILABLE was steadied behind rivals heading towards the turn, regrouped and angled out, circled five wide into the lane, ranged up outside rivals leaving the sixteenth marker but was outfinished for the place. MADE BAIL advanced outside and went clear into the turn, dropped in towards the rail then was joined by JOE TESS leaving the three eighths, dueled from the five sixteenths to upper, saw that rival kick clear in mid stretch, came back along the rail a sixteenth out and kept on gamely. JOE TESS broke a step slow, recovered and moved up four wide past the half mile marker, dropped in a bit and engaged MADE BAIL mid turn, dueled, spurted clear in mid stretch then weakened in the final yards. TIGER TANK, between rivals into the turn, angled out for the drive but lacked a rally. SIR ROCKPORT, away last after breaking outward and hitting the gate, had his rider briefly lose his balance before recovering, advanced inside to be close up into the turn, failed to keep pace into the stretch and weakened. EXAGGERATED ran off some when fractious pre race, broke on top and led early, rated back off of MADE BAIL nearing the turn and secured the inside, did not rate kindly and steadied a bit behind the leaders mid turn, failed to kick on in upper stretch and gave way.
