MJC will no longer be accepting blood drawn slips for coggins. The coggins MUST come back negative and turned into Horse ID. Must be within 365 days of the date the blood was drawn.

TRAINERS: YOU MUST HANG YOUR "IN TODAY" SIGNS ON YOUR HORSES STALL DOOR ON RACE DAY. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN A SCRATCH AND FINE!

Horses coming to the paddock with lip chains MUST have them covered! Horses paddock schooling must also have covered lip chains.

ATTENTION HORSEMEN: Personal checks and cash will no longer be accepted for Digital Tattoos. Please make sure to have money in your horsemen's account. A voucher must be present or you may use a credit card for your horse to be digitally tattooed.

1ST TIME GELDINGS: Private vets MUST notify the horse identifier when a horse is gelded. Michele Enck- ext. 5473. michele.enck@marylandracing.com. Trainers MUST state 1st time gelding when making an entry.

SHOE RULE REMINDER FOR TURF:

Traction devices are prohibited on both front and hind hooves. Traction devices include but are not limited to rims, toe grabs, bends, jar caulks, and stickers.

BLACK EYED SUSAN AND PREAKNESS DAY TRAINING HOURS:

Training at Pimlico on Black-Eyed Susan Day, Friday, May 19, will be 5:00am-8:30am, no break.

Training at Laurel on Black-Eyed Susan Day, Friday, May 19, will be 5:30am-9:30am, break at 7:00am.

Training at Pimlico on Preakness Day, Saturday, May 20, will be from 5:00am-6:00am. Only horses racing Preakness Day are permitted to train on this day. You must get permission from Terry Overmier to get onto the track.

Training at Laurel on Preakness Day, Saturday, May 20, will be from 5:30am-8:30am. No break and no schooling.

No training at Pimlico Race Course or Laurel Park on Sunday, May 21.

Special post times:

Black Eyed Susan Day 11:30am Preakness Day 10:30am

Entry Requirements:

Trainer will not enter a horse in any race on Black-Eyed Susan Day or Preakness Day UNLESS the horse has: (a) been examined by Trainer's Attending Veterinarian once during the three (3) days immediately preceding the entry to race for the express purpose of evaluating the horse's fitness to race; and (b) been found fit to race by the Attending Veterinarian. This evaluation shall include, at a minimum palpation and passive flexion of the forelimbs and watching the horse jog.

The Attending Veterinarian must submit verification of examination and fitness to race to the 1/ST Racing Chief Veterinary Officer at dionne.benson@stronachgroup.com. If no verification is submitted the horse will be scratched. The Attending Veterinarian and trainer are obligated to inform the Chief Veterinary Officer of any changes in the horse's fitness after entry and before race day.
